ich **welkte**  
du **welktest**  
er **welkte**  
wir **welkten**  
ihr **welktet**  
sie **welkten**

**gewelkt**

### Infinitives

**welken**  
**zu welken**  
**gewelkt sein**  
**gewelkt zu sein**
